Why Are You Getting This Notice?

Revocation of Your Tax-Exempt Status

Your organization will lose its tax-exempt status if you fail to meet your annual filing requirement for three consecutive years. Therefore, if you do not file the e-Postcard or an information return, Form 990 or 990-EZ, for three consecutive years, your tax-exempt status will be revoked as of the filing due date of the third year.

You must apply (or reapply) and pay the appropriate user fee to have your tax-exempt status reinstated if it was revoked because you failed to file for three consecutive years. Reinstatement of tax-exempt status may be retroactive if you can show you had reasonable cause for not filing. To apply for tax-exempt status, use Form 1023, Application for Recognition of Exemption, or Form 1024, Application for Exemption Under Section 501(a).
